Benefits

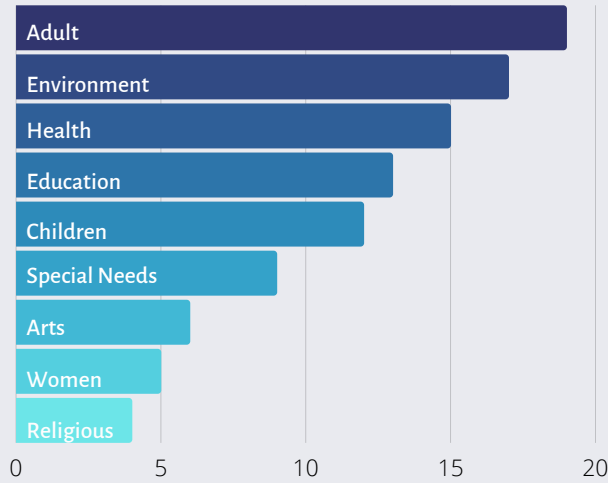
Organizations can deploy a Rice MBA student's ideas and energy to solve a problem or execute a project with the possibility of cultivating a future board member.
