DEGREE PROGRAMS

Recruiting and Admissions

Full-Time MBA (FTMBA) Applications

Since the close of Round 2 on January 5, Full-Time MBA (FTMBA) application momentum has remained strong; we have seen a **37%** increase in FTMBA application creations year-over-year, as well as an**8% increase** in FTMBA application submissions year-over-year.

Decisions for Round 2 will be released on March 29, and the final Round 3 deadline for FTMBA applications is April 5, 2019.

Our team of second-year FTMBA Admissions Ambassadors has also been busy conducting admissions interviews over the past month, with **97%** of Round 2 interviews complete as of the end of February. We plan to begin recruiting the next cohort of FTMBA Ambassadors from the first-year class after their return from spring break.

Professional (PMBA) and Executive MBA (EMBA) Applications

Consistent with the exponential nature of rolling admissions, we continue to see increases in application submissions for the PMBA-Evening (**26% increase** year-over-year), PMBA-Weekend (**19% increase** year-over-year), and EMBA (**28% increase** year-over-year) programs.

Fully employed program enrollment has also accelerated, with PMBA programs **up 13** total enrollments year-over-year and the EMBA program **up six** enrollments year-over-year. We expect to see these trends continue as we approach May 27 – the final application deadline for PMBA and EMBA apps.

After a year of service (and over 250 interviews conducted!), we are working to roll off our current second-year PMBA Admissions Ambassadors before they become too busy with Capstone work. We hope to assemble a new team of PMBA Ambassadors from the first-year class by early March.



Events
