William H. McRaven, a retired U.S. Navy four-star admiral and SEAL, serves as the University of Texas System Chancellor leading one of the nation's largest and most respected systems of higher education. Prior to becoming chancellor, McRaven was the commander of U.S. Special Operations Command during which time he led a force of 69,000 men and women and was responsible for conducting counter-terrorism operations worldwide including Operation Neptune Spear, the special operations raid that led to the death of Osama Bin Laden on May 2, 2011. In June of 2016, United States Secretary of Defense Ash Carter named Chancellor McRaven as one of the first appointees to the newly formed Defense Innovation Advisory Board, advising the Pentagon on strategies to cultivate a culture of innovation in national defense.

Rice Veterans Leadership Series (RVLS)

The Rice Veteran Leadership Series is an annual event organized by VIBA honoring a nationally known veteran. This event features veterans who have excelled in business, the arts and public service. Past speakers have included former Governor and first Secretary of Homeland Defense Tom Ridge, former Heisman Trophy Winner and CEO Pete Dawkins, former Commandant of the Marine Corps James Conway and other distinguished veterans. The event is also intended to raise awareness of the growing number of VIBA students on scholarship at the Jones Graduate School of Business.

The Military Scholars Program (MSP)

The program is a scholarship fund and support network dedicated to benefiting military applicants to the full-time Rice MBA program and current full-time MBA military students. Candidates are recruited and reviewed in conjunction with the traditional admissions process. Final candidates and spouses are hosted for on-campus interviews and opportunities to meet alumni and current students. The program objective is to increase military personnel applications and acceptances to the business school.

A portion of all sponsorship proceeds goes to support the Military Scholars Program.
